

Bob Bojorcas Scholarship

Philosophy

To provide a scholarship for a college (or technical school) bound Native American youth with a preference to students who have proven an aptitude for, and a commitment to, sports.

Provide up to two (2) \$ 1,000 scholarships at each of the following schools: Ocosta High School, Raymond High School, Willapa Valley High School and South Bend High School. Eligible students will be, at a minimum, a college bound Native American senior. The preferred student will have participated in, and shown an aptitude for, sport. Number of years and number of sports participated in may be used to determine the recipient, but neither are required to give the award to a college bound Native American senior. Award will be given directly to the recipient(s) after proof of-enrollment in college.

The Education Department reserves the right to award (at our discretion) up to \$2,000 additional dollars from this account annually for the purpose of providing sports related funds (\$1,000 maximum award) to clubs, camps or enrolled member youth. To apply for these funds, a written request must be submitted to the Education Director describing the activity and related expenses (receipts may be required).
